**EDUCATION**

In November Aux. Units pay special attention to our children, their schools, teachers, and other staff members as part of American Education month. I know you have lots of ideas how to make them feel education is special. Our program includes sharing reading time with students, arranging for Veterans to share their stories in the classrooms, participating in the Give 10 to Education program, and/or honoring the school staff some special way.

At this time it is important to make the scholarship forms available to the eligible seniors. This may be done by giving copies of them to the school counselor, Senior advisor, or Administrators. The Nontraditional Scholarship is harder to distribute. We need to advertise it in creative ways so people returning to school again will be able to apply. Talk about it at meetings or place it in community bulletins. Perhaps someone at the school would know if a person has applied to a college.

Encourage your local schools to help their students enter the Oratorical speech contest. In doing this they will become experts on our Constitution, and as a by product, become eligible to earn college scholarships.
